Oct. 20: You Asked for It



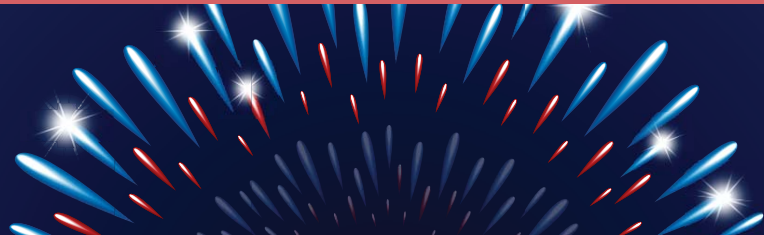
