- There was discussion of how to inform our youth orchestra members and patrons about the pause. Jennifer will work with Greg and Jill to send an email to last year's members and Cathy will put a notice on our website.

Board members and Orchestra Management

- The suggestion was made to hire a business manager or executive director, Steve knows someone who might be interested and will talk to him,
- The board would like to see orchestra members attend meetings without being on the board, Steve will check legalities to make sure this is acceptable.
- Dan made a motion to have board meeting minutes approved via email in order to have timely distribution of minutes. The motion passed unanimously.

Personnel

- Dan made a motion to have \$2100 available for each concert to hire up to seven string players. Pay is \$100 per service, for three services or \$300 per hire per concert. The motion passed with one dissenting vote.
- Upcoming auditions were discussed.

Rehearsals and Concerts

- Concert dates are set and will be at Meridian High School. Rehearsal space is still being negotiated,
- Concert dress was discussed and set as follows:
 - **Option 1:** Black tuxedo or suit jacket, white long-sleeve dress shirt, black bowtie, black dress pants, black socks, and black shoes
 - Option 2: All black outfit of a formal dress or separates, with three-quarters to long sleeves, and long skirt or dress pants. Black socks or hose, and black shoes.

The symphony picnic is Saturday, August 26, 6-8 p.m., at Kleiner Park. The symphony will provide pizza. Members and their families should bring a side or dessert, along with their own beverages.
